Created in 1997, the **STARS** for Children Project is a partnership of the Retired and Senior Volunteer Program (RSVP) and the Broward County School Board, a project to bring together *Seniors and Teachers to Achieve Reading Success (STARS)*.

The program's focus is on supporting the "American Reads" goal to have students reading at grade level by the time they finish 3rd grade. RSVP volunteers are placed in targeted Title 1 schools, to tutor readers in first, second and third grades that need assistance. Volunteers are given training through RSVP to prepare them for their assignment.



Reading assessments are used as pre and post measurements to evaluate the progress of the students. Every year there has been consistent improvement in student achievement in reading. We ask volunteers to serve a minimum of 4 hours a week.

This program works because of hard working students, committed teachers, and the dedication of RSVP VOLUNTEERS.

Let's work together in our community to improve the reading level for our first, second and third graders.
